## Dear Herman

Thank you for providing us with MathTutor.

At Hope Farm we are a large family who makes ourselves available to help children in need. We have seven children from 3 to 14 yrs who are permanently part of the family. Then we often have other children of all ages that we are caring for . At present we have twin boys under a year and a six year old child with special needs. We home-school as many of our children are emotionally and educationally unable to cope at a mainstream school. Before we discovered MathTutor we tried various Maths programmes. Most of them were text books with answer books for the teacher. Some included workbooks. Over years we have tried many different programmes and courses. Some we wanted to try were too expensive for us. Most of the programmes we tried did not explain the work adequately for a home-school situation.
